#010: Marnik Neven: White space II

Short description:

Part 1: Glue A4-papers on a wall in the public space.

Part 2: The next day go back and remove the paper.

Preparations:

- For the glue use 10gr of flour.and 300ml water,
- mix and heat it,
- let it boil a few minutes and stir well,
- when cooled, pour the mix into a container.
- buy some cheap copy paper or sketch paper
- get a piece of plastic or a plastic bag
- a large brush
- a cloth
- a spraying bottle.

Execution

Part 1:

Go to the wall of your choice. Any kind of public „wall“ will do.

Prepare 20 - 30 peaces of paper, don't do more at the same time as they will dry and stick together. grease the paper with glue, and lay them on the plastic bag.

Place them one by one on the wall to cover up the space you want. Use the cloth to smooth it out.

Part 2:

The next day go back. Use the spraying bottle and bring some extra bottles of water.

spray the papers, and keep them wet for about a half hour. Now you can peel of the papers one by one. Collect them in a box or envelope.

If you want you can sent the papers to me. You can contact me to make arrangements for the portal costs. Let me know the exact place where you performed the action.
