#022: Jess Rose: Coact (2014)

For this piece, the act of taking photographs produces both the performance and the performance document. I'm interested in revealing the presence of the performer through the images they have captured themselves; in following these instructions, their physicality and subjectivity will be revealed to a certain extent.

It is likely that this series of actions will go unnoticed;

to see a person exploring a place through a lens is to be expected.

The volunteer will require one disposable camera, and has to perform the following 27 tasks:

Take a photograph from the ground

Take a photograph of a person who walks ahead of you

Take a photograph of a person who walks behind you

Take a photograph at arm's length

Take a photograph of a blonde

Take a photograph with your eyes closed

Take a photograph from chest level

Take a photograph of a word or words

Take a photograph of people holding hands

Take a photograph of something you are sure you'll remember Take a photograph from the highest place you can reach

Take a photograph from the most comfortable place you can find Take a photograph of the time

Take a photograph of a cigarette

Take a photograph of a conversation

Take a photograph of a reflection

Take a photograph of something or someone that turns you on Take a photograph of a photograph

Take a photograph of music

Take a photograph as you drop the camera

Take a photograph of the weather

Take a photograph over your shoulder

Take a photograph from a hidden place

Take a photograph as you jump

Take a photograph looking up

Take a photograph looking down

Take a photograph of someone looking at you
