Repair it using a method which makes the repair obvious.

The repair can be perfect or imperfect;  
it is the act of repairing which is important.

Repair methods to consider:

- Embroider / sew together
- Staple
- Grout
- Glue
- Knot / tie up
- Patchwork
- Solder
- Paint
- Plaster
- Nail /screw together
- Wax
- Reconstruct
