## #046:Frans van Lent: Walk the horizon (2016)

- Go for a walk in a natural area.
  - Choose a spot with a view and make a photo of the landscape.
  - Look at the horizon on your photo.
  - On the photo find a recognisable spot on the left side and a spot on the right side of the horizon.
  - Transfer these spots to your map; connect these spots with a line.
  - Go and find the location marked with the right spot and from there start walking in the direction of the left spot.
- Stay as close as possible to the line on the map.
- The walk is finished when you reached the left spot.
