The performance is preferably executed on soil in a park or a field. A parking lot or a square can also be used, but this will change the interpretation.

You need a kilo of coarse sea salt and a large can filled with water. Dress casually.

-Draw a spiral with the salt. Start with a thin line at little distance and make the line thicker and the spiral wider as you proceed.

-When all the salt has been used, slowly start watering the line from the outside to the centre.

-When finished start all over again. The salt will dissolve slowly.

-Continue until the salt can no longer be distinguished or until you run out of water.
