Get a shovel and find a place where you can dig.

Start digging a hole on the spot where you are standing and put the dirt in a pile next to you. While you dig, the pile will slowly grow and you will sink into the ground. Do not take breaks.

The performance is done the moment you can no longer look over the pile from where you are standing.

Alternatively, the performance is done when the ground water reaches your ankles.

You have now created your own human scaled land art piece.
